Access

Enter the URL <https://statswales.wales.gov.uk/Catalogue> into your web browser.

This takes you to the introductory web page about StatsWales and has links to tutorials to help you use the service and other features such as setting up e-mail alerts. This website is bilingual, click on the Cymraeg link to access the site in Welsh.

Locating data

There are two ways to search for data:-

1. Browse the Catalogue on the left menu. Some categories have sub-levels. Navigate to the dataset required.
2. Use the search box found in the top right corner. You will get a list of results matching your search term(s).

Data toolbar

On the **Actions** tab you have:

1. **Revert** – to remove all customisation and return to the original view.
2. **Link** – creates a hyperlink for the dataset as shown. If you customise it, the hyperlink will be for that set, not the original.
3. **Export** – here you can export the dataset as shown in Excel.
4. **Print** – presents your information as shown in a printable version.
5. **Full screen** – removes some website information so you can more easily view the dataset. In full screen mode click again to return to normal view.

Organising data

Once you have your dataset you can customize the view by clicking on the + or – for the categories on the left. You can use the drop down menus on headers to choose specific elements to display.

Chart tab

Click on the **Chart** tab and **Show chart**. The default is a bar chart but you can change this using the options in the toolbar.

You can customise your view of the data using the same options as before.
